



Medicare and Its Provisions for Christian Scientists

Medicare is a complex topic with unique applications for Christian Scientists. The three Christian Science organizations listed below provide a range of useful information. Among other things, they explain how to sign up for Medicare, as well as how a Christian Scientist might be able to use Medicare for their Christian Science nursing care.



<u>Arden Wood</u> — This Christian Science care facility in the San Francisco area contains a page on their website with an overview of how Medicare works in a Christian Science context. The page features a 15-page downloadable pdf which serves as a detailed look at the topic. Some of the information is specific to Arden Wood or California, but most of it applies to anyone wanting to learn about Medicare for Christian Scientists.



<u>AOCSN</u> — The Association of Christian Science Nursing has a web page that summarizes many of the details specific to using Medicare in a Christian Science nursing facility that accepts Medicare. To Medicare, these organizations are known as "Religious Nonmedical Healthcare Institutions" or RNHCl's.
