Nesterly — Located in **Boston** and in **Columbus**, **OH**, this program specializes in home-sharing that matches up young adults with seniors. There's a modest initial contract fee and both host and guests pay Nesterly 2.5% of the rent. The monthly rents generally run anywhere from \$300 - \$900. 877-958-8785 nesterly.io
